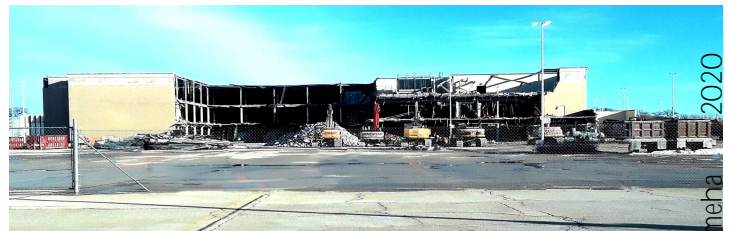
Lot of happy little faces and students enjoy the unbelievable sources of the Northbrook Library!
